Ladies & gentlemen,

It is my great pleasure to welcome you to mark the end of West Pokot County Agricultural Show & Trade Fair - 2023. I also take this opportunity to welcome all visitors to West Pokot County—"The Land of Hidden Treasures". The County is endowed with fertile soils and favourable climate suitable for most crops. This positions our County strategically in terms of its overall contribution to the national food security. Agriculture is the main driver of our economy and contributes significantly in terms of income generation and employment creation. This Agricultural show is therefore an important event that provides an opportunity for farmers, traders, marketing agents and other service providers to access modern farming technologies,





establish business linkages and promote Agribusiness for increased Agriculture productivity, wealth and employment creation.

The County of West Pokot recognizes the significant role that the agricultural sector plays in meeting the national objectives of employment creation, food security, poverty reduction and industrial transformation that are necessary drivers for economic growth. This is also geared towards achieving the county's vision of being a food secure and wealthy county anchored on an innovative, commercially oriented and competitive agriculture, rural & urban development sector.

Farmers face numerous challenges such as increase in population leading to decreasing land sizes, climate change leading to prolonged drought and weather changes, inadequate access to markets, equipment and resources.

Ladies & Gentlemen,

One of the key aspects of a better future for our farmers is advanced technology. My Government, through the Department of Agriculture has initiated and achieved the following projects, aimed towards enhanced innovations and technologies which include;

- Promotion of appropriate & affordable fertilizers in partnership with the national government
- Promotion of avocado for food, income & increasing tree cover which will then help in mitigating against the adverse effects of Climate change,
- ✓ Promotion of greenhouse crop production & conservation agriculture.
- ✓ Development of farmers database (E.g. In the just ended farmer registration exercise where 91,077 farmers were registered including all enterprises e.g. Livestock, Crops etc. The data will inform key decision making going forward.
- ✓ Promoting urban & peri-urban farming by the use of multi storey gardens
- ✓ Water harvesting for small holder farmers
- ✓ Use of free Certified seeds
- ✓ In addition, enterprise diversification has been up scaled to enhance farmers' income throughout the year as well as building resilience especially in view of





the imminent risks posed by Climate Change. This involves promotion of drought tolerant Maize varieties, fruit trees, Green grams, Sorghum & Finger Millet.

Similarly, in the livestock sub sector, projects under implementation include;

- ✓ Improved local poultry
- ✓ Livestock Feed processing and formulation
- ✓ Dairy genetic improvement (by offering free A.I services)
- ✓ Promoting Milk pasteurization & Packing in Siyoi Ward.
- ✓ Livestock disease control (acaricide support)
- Routine & rapid vaccination of animals e.g. the ongoing Vaccination against Foot & Mouth Disease- FMD, Rabies which is currently ongoing in affected areas across the County.
- ✓ Cattle dip renovations and assorted Livestock feed establishment.

As a sign of my Government's commitment, I recently commissioned equipment, tools and materials to promote the above technologies. These include: -
